1. Can anyone participate?

Participation in Homeschool Singapore's Sports Day is only open to homeschoolers, and the family race for their family members and themselves.

- 2. \$30 for each family? Is there a maximum number of family members that can register? Yes, it's only \$30 for each family unit, regardless of the number of children you have.
- 3. Can I register for as many events as I'm interested in?
  In the interest of sportsmanship, each participant is only allowed to register for a maximum of 3 races (EXCLUDING family race).
- **4.** How can I indicate my interest?

Simply enter your details in the Google form, send in your payment details to sportsday@homeschoolsingapore.sg with the following details:

- Name of payee
- Amount paid
- Transaction reference
- Screenshot of payment or photo of receipt for ATM transfers We will send you an acknowledgement email to let you know you have secured your place.
- 5. How do I make payment?Payment can be made to OCBC Savings 527-1-032137.
- 6. How do I know if my payment has been received?An acknowledgement email will be sent to you after registration has closed.
- 7. When is the last day of registration?1 June but don't delay!



**8.** I can't confirm if I can make it on that day. Do you accept walk-in registrations on that day?

Unfortunately we will not be accepting walk-in registrations on that day.

- 9. How do I determine which age group should I register my child for?
  Your child should be signed up based on the calendar year, regardless of the birth month.
- 10. I want to join the relay but I don't have enough team members, what should I do? Simply indicate your other team members, if any. We will try our best to match other participants to your team, if necessary.
- 11. What is the family race?

  The family race is a non-competitive race for all members of the family, including your grandparents!
- 12. Can I combine with other families and register for the family race?

  Yes, you may combine with other families to form a team. If you are combining with other families, just have a representative to register on the Google form.

  Remember to indicate all the names of your participants! If you do not have enough members, fret not. We will try our best to match other participants to your team, if necessary.
- 13. Is there an age limit for the family race?It's opened to anyone from 3 to 99 years old! We are only able to accommodate 8 teams though, so fastest fingers first!



**14.** Something came up and I can't make it. Can my friend race on my behalf or can I ask for a refund?

We appreciate your understanding that tickets sold are non-transferable or refundable.

15. What happens if it rains? Hails? Haze?

We reserve the right to cancel the event should the weather become unsuitable. Notification will be posted on the event page 1 hour before the event. Remember, safety first!

- 16. Will my tickets be refunded in the event of cancellation?

  Unfortunately, tickets will not be refunded as the funds have been used for the booking of the stadium, and other necessary items.
- 17. What time do I need to report for my event?

  Attendance taking starts at 1:15pm and will close at 2pm. No late-comers will be allowed to participate in the race(s). Once you have taken your attendance, listen out for your event timing and report to the marshals at the reporting area.
- 18. Will there be a medical team on standby?No, there will not be a medical team on standby. If necessary, please seek your doctor's advice before registering.
